



## Don't Forget 'HOOK' With Your Fungicide

It seems like many different parts of the country are experiencing a lot more rainfall than usual this year. There was an unsubstantiated news item commenting on a run on scuba gear in the Midwest.

So, it would come as no surprise that growers would be adding fungicides to their chemical shopping list this month.

We would like to remind everyone about adding **Hook** when that fungicide application is made. Remember, **Hook** works with all types of pesticides.

### *Report on Chemigation with Hook at Burford Farms, California*

'We wanted to find out what would happen if we chemigated fungicides complexed with **Hook**'. This was the first trial.

June 8

Rovveral DF was premixed with Diathane in 250 gal of water, then added 2 gallons of **Hook** and mixed for 20 min to let it complex with the fungicides. This solution was then chemigated on dehydrated onions.

Roveral 1½ pounds per acre      Diathane 1 pound per acre      **HOOK 1 pint per acre**

"ADD **HOOK** LAST"

The mildew control was equal for a week or more after the treatment. There appeared to be more residue on the **Hook** treated area.

June 24

The treated area with **Hook** was significantly different. The disease was substantially less. It was healthier and greener to the exact sprinkler pattern in the middle of the field. There was 6.4 pints of mix per 100 gal of ride.
